

OF EASTER

First Reading: (Acts 9:26-31) Paul in today's First Reading seeks to be grafted onto the visible expression of Christ the true vine—His Church. Once the chief persecutor of the Church, Paul encounters initial resistance and suspicion. But he is known by his fruits, by his powerful witness to the Lord working in his life (see <u>Matthew 7:16–20</u>).

Second Reading: (1 John 3:18-24) We need to always remain rooted in Him, as today's Epistle tells us. We remain in Him by keeping His commandment of love, by pondering His words, letting them dwell richly in us (see <u>Colossians 3:16</u>), and by always seeking to do what pleases Him. In everything we must be guided by humility, remembering that apart from Him we can do nothing.

<u>**Gospel:**</u> (John 15: 1-5) In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that He is the true vine that God intended Israel to be—the source of divine life and wisdom for the nations (see <u>Sirach 24:17–24</u>). **https:// stpaulcenter.com/reflections for more info.**

PARABLE OF A PRAYER AND A BANK ACCOUNT

"When are you going to get your new bike, Johnny?" said Larry. "I don't know if I will ever get it now," said John. "What's the matter? Won't your father give it to you?" inquired his friend.
