# Sunday Readings

First Reading: (Job 7: 1-4, 6-7) In today's First Reading, Job describes the futility of life before Christ. His lament reminds us of the curse of toil and death placed upon Adam following his original sin (see Genesis 3:17–19). Men and women are like slaves seeking shade, unable to find rest. Their lives are like the wind that comes and goes.

Second Reading: (1 Corinthians 9:16-19, 22-23) Our lives must be our thanksgiving, as Paul describes in today's Epistle. We must tell everyone the good news, the purpose for which Jesus has come-that others, too, may have a share in this salvation.

Gospel: (Mark 1:29-39) Notice all the words of totality and completeness in the Gospel. The whole town gathers; all the sick are brought to Him. He drives out demons in the whole of Galilee. Everyone is looking for Christ.







We were also gifted \$1500.00 in grocery cards from St. Vincent de Paul in Okotoks, and have given out \$300.00 of that so far. The total assistance we have given so far is \$10, 306.89
