<u>Sunday Readings</u>

First Reading: (Jonah 3: 1-5, 10) And we should be consoled by Nineveh's repentance in today's First Reading. Even the wicked Nineveh could repent at Jonah's preaching. And in Jesus we have "something greater than Jonah" (Matthew 12:41).

Second Reading: (1 Corinthians 7:29-31) From now on, even our most important worldly concerns—family relations, occupations, and possessions—must be judged in light of the Gospel, Paul says in today's Epistle.

Gospel: (Mark 1:14-20) By Jesus' Cross and Resurrection, this new exodus has begun (see <u>Luke 9:31</u>). And the apostles are the first of a new people of God, the Church—a new family, based not on blood ties, but on belief in Jesus and a desire to do the Father's will (see <u>John 1:12-13</u>; <u>Matthew 12:46-50</u>).

Explaining the impossible to the unknowing describes much of the mission and message of Jesus.







It also offers practical tools to plan for seen and unforeseen circumstances. Finally, it can help us to find hope in our Catholic faith, and choose to live well until the end of our natural lives.

Fr Mariusz, in every funeral homily, says that we must "practice dying". He means that we need to prepare for the challenges that are certain to come with dying before they arrive and overwhelm us; that faith-based education around dying and death will help to allay the fear we and our families feel when looking at the reality of dying and death; that building resources through our faith will help to support us in this imminent journey.

If you wish to take this course in the comfort of your own home, this course is also available online through Zoom and group discussion is facilitated through "breakout rooms".

All donations can be dropped off at SFDS in the basket in the church hall.





A huge **Thank You** to all those who have made a donation to this rewarding ministry.


