#### Sunday Readings

**First Reading:** (Acts 10:34a, 37-43) What they saw and believed they bore witness to, as today's First Reading tells us. Peter's speech is a summary of the gospels—from Jesus' baptism in the Jordan t His hanging on a tree (see <u>Deuteronomy 21:22–23</u>), to His rising from the dead.

**Second Reading:** (Colossians 3:1-4) We are children of the apostles, born into the new world of their witness. Our lives are now "hidden with Christ in God," as today's Epistle says. Like them, we gather in the morning on the first day of the week —to celebrate the Eucharist, the feast of the empty tomb.

**Gospel:** (John 20:1-18) We rejoice that the stones have been rolled away from our tombs, too. Each of us can shout, as we do in today's Psalm: "I shall not die, but live." They saw and believed. 
